TRAINER

Mr. Prathamesh D. Popat (founder: **Prachi**) is an Advocate, an Accredited Mediator and a Senior Mediation Trainer of MCPC. He has Mediation experience spanning over two decades and conducts basic and advanced workshops for training mediators.

He is an empanelled Mediator in several institutions, including the Bombay High Court and has mediated disputes referred to him directly as well as by various courts. He regularly trains professionals, students and others in the art of Mediation & Conciliation. He is a certified Mediator of IMI (International Mediation Institute) based in The Hague. He has authored several articles on Mediation, has contributed to several international publications and is the author of the Monograph Series publication of the CTC (Chamber of Tax Consultants) on the topic of **Mediation & Conciliation**.

OBJECTIVES

Mediation is a resolutionary process whereby the Mediator, a trained neutral person, facilitates a conversation between disputing parties and supports them in understanding each other's interests and concerns and thereby affording them an opportunity to negotiate amongst themselves a mutually acceptable agreement. Mediation is an art as well as a scientific process. Realizing the importance of the mechanism, the Judiciary in India has taken steps to encourage Mediation as an ideal process for resolving disputes and thereby reduce the burden of pending cases in courts in India. Even the Parliament is considering having a dedicated law to govern the field of Mediation. The success of the Mediation process depends upon the ability and skill of the Mediator in collaboratively engaging the parties in this process so as to create an environment that encourages a meaningful dialogue focused on addressing the concerns and interests of the disputing parties. The intent and content of the workshop is to give the Participants a hands-on experience in learning the skills of a mediator. It will hence enable the participants to not only get a sense of the Mediation as a process but will also afford them the opportunity to systematically understand the role of the Mediator so as to be able to grasp the concepts, learn the techniques and practice them.
