Besides inaugural and valedictory, there will be panel discussion on equity markets (Mainboard and SME platforms), including derivatives, Commodity and Currency Derivative Markets, Debt Markets, and Technology, with discussants who are thought leaders in their respective domains.

The conference is expected to generate meaningful insights on market integration, regulatory coordination, institutional participation and the future trajectory of India's financial markets. Through discussions across diverse segments and stakeholders, it aims to contribute to a deeper

understanding of the structural challenges and opportunities in building a resilient, efficient and globally competitive financial ecosystem.
