Round Table with MMRDA on Tues 16th January 2018 at 3.00 pm

We are pleased to inform that **MMRDA** has proposed **Multimodal Corridor (MC)** between Virar (Mumbai) and Alibaug via JNPT which is 126 km long, and will be built at a cost of Rs.10,000 crores (Phase I from Navghar to Chirner near JNPT), and stretch from Virar/Navghar to Alibaug, running through Panvel, JNPT and Chirner.

Considering the fact that significant container shipping traffic moves on this same route to/from the JNPT and between the CFSs, IMC through Shipping and Logistics Committee (SLC) would like to facilitate interaction with key officials from MMRDA, JNPT, CIDCO, NHAI and DFC.
