Arbitrations resulting in arbitral awards are only half the battle, whereafter issues of challenges, execution and enforcement arise, which is the focus of this Seminar.

Eminent speakers and panellists, including Mr. Janak Dwarkadas (Senior Counsel) and Mr. Gaurang Mehta (Advocate) will share their knowledge, expertise, experiences and views, which will be followed by interactive discussions with participants in their respective sessions. The speakers and panellists shall also endeavour to deal with and cover various practical aspects.

OBJECTIVE

The Seminar is likely to be of immense value, given that the 2015 Amendments also affect the arbitration process and usually its desired culmination in an Award. Key issues will be addressed at this Seminar by Senior Counsel and panel Counsel, Solicitors & Advocates, having experience and expertise in the field of arbitration.

The Government of India and the Judiciary are taking several steps for speedy dispensation of justice through the Courts of Law in view of the arrears of pending cases and influx of new cases. Various steps are also being taken to support and promote Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) methods including arbitration, which are useful and effective for resolving commercial disputes expeditiously and more so through arbitral institutions like the IIAC rather than ad-hoc arbitrations. Arbitration being one of the preferred ADR methods for resolving disputes, there is a need for practitioners and those involved with arbitrations to keep abreast with the recent amendments and developments, not only on the legal aspects, but also in the practical applications.

Recognizing this need, IMC, through its Arbitration Committee, has, for the past several years, taken upon itself the task of creating awareness of arbitration, and also arranging Courses, Seminars, Conferences and Workshops attended and conducted by persons of eminence in the field.
